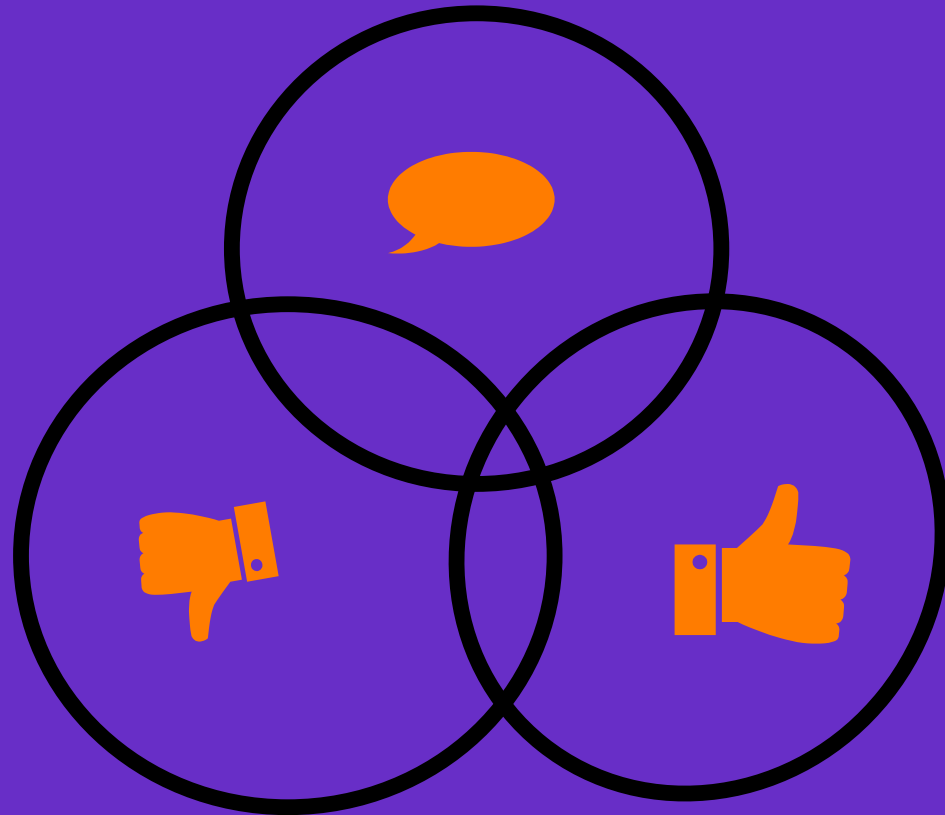
- ⦿ Think about a personal experience you want to turn into a story, maybe it's one of the four sentences from your life story.
- ⦿ Focus on one key moment—one event, or one place or one important relationship. It doesn't have to be about anything queer.
- ⦿ Take some time to think about the elements of your story in the context of the **challenge, choice** and **outcome**
- ⦿ Keep your story short, give yourself a limit of 2-3 min.
- ⦿ Write down your story, yes write it down.

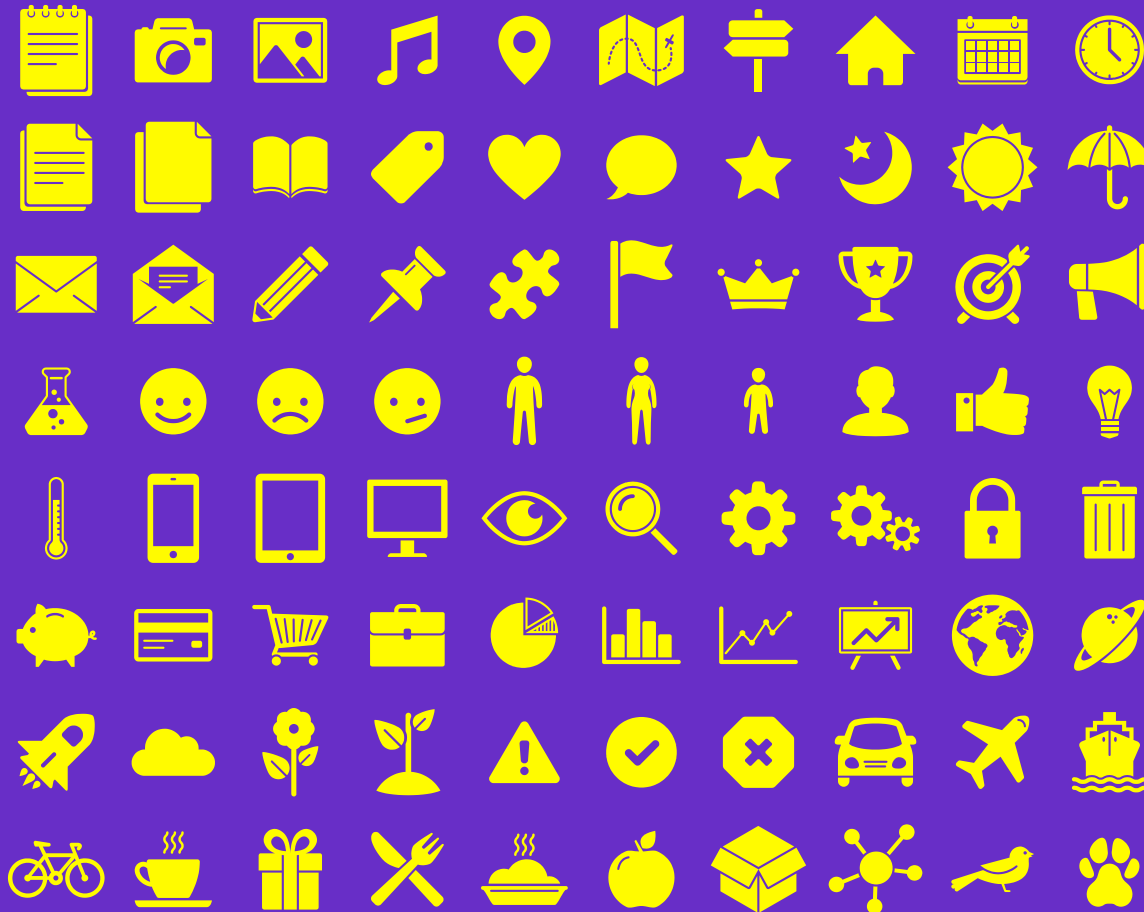
